Intermediate to Advanced. Co-taught by Adam and Vianney, the first six weeks of this course will focus on teacups, teabowls, yunomis, chawans, and other "satellite" items surrounding the teapot, while the second half will culminate in the making of teapots and completing sets. This course focuses on the wheel, namely discussing strategies for creating consistent sets, throwing off the hump, and ultimately assembling teapots and dealing with the challenges of their many parts. Some experience making lids and handles and throwing off the hump is recommended but not mandatory.
